

Wolf Creek Monitoring Site Descriptions as of August 2006

West Dayton – R.M. 2.36

Behind Adventure Central at 2222 James H. MaGee Blvd. Into driveway, go to the right, around perimeter fence, park directly behind building. Cross the foot bridge and monitor on upstream side.

Royer Residence, West of Trotwood – R.M. 1.8 North Branch

Residence of Judy Royer, 4777 Oakes Rd. Creek is directly behind house, about 100 yards. Going West on Wolf Creek Pike out of Trotwood, turn right on Snyder Rd; it comes to a T at Snake Rd., turn right. As road veers sharp to the left at the top of a small hill is Judy's house on left (road name changes to Oakes)

Henderson Residence – R. M. 3.07 North Branch

Residence of Jim Henderson, 301 N. Diamond Mill Rd., Clayton. Going north on Diamond Mill from Westbrook Rd., cross over I-70, pass 2 stop signs. Road will go downhill toward bridge over creek, Jim's driveway is on the left, before you cross the North Branch of Wolf Creek. Monitoring site on opposite (east) side of the road.

Ebright Residence – R.M. 11.64

Going west on Wolf Creek Pike from Diamond Mill; just past the bridge that goes over the creek, Heeter Rd. veers off to the left near cottage-type house. Residence of Ronald and Linda Ebright, Wolf Creek Pike and Heeter Rd. Enter on north side of creek, near bridge. Park opposite house, near # 10595/10597 mailboxes.

Wolf Creek at Westbrook Rd. – R.M. 15.32

Go toward Brookville on Wolf Creek Pike. As you come into town, the first stop sign is Westbrook Rd. The creek is next to Trinity Lutheran Church.
