Deciduous Trees (Native)

	<u>Size</u>	<u>Species</u>	<u>Price</u>
Basswood, American Height 50-80', up to 50' wide. Full sun to part shade, moist to well-drained soils. Heart-shaped leaves. Abundant small, fragrant pale yellow spring flowers loved by bees led to the nickname 'bee tree'.	1-2'	<i>Tilia americana</i>	1 for \$3, 5 for \$21
NEW! Beech, American Grows 50 -80' tall and 40-80' wide in full sun to part shade. Slow growing. Distinctive thin smooth gray bark. Dark green leaves turn golden bronze in the fall. Edible beechnuts ripen in fall.	12-18"	<i>Fagus grandifolia</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$7
Birch, River Grows 40 -70' tall and up to 60' wide in full sun to part shade. Fast growing. Does well in medium to wet soils. Peeling bark adds winter interest. Very valuable to birds for seeds and nesting.	12-18"	<i>Betula nigra</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
NEW! Buckeye, Ohio Ohio's State Tree. Grows to 30'. The "buckeye" seed is encased in a spiny round fruit, about two inches around, containing the two dark brown shiny buckeyes.	12-18"	<i>Aesculus glabra</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$8
NEW! Cherry, Black Grows up to 60' tall and 30' wide in full sun to part shade. Clusters of white blooms in spring produce red to purple fruit loved by wildlife and useful for making jam. Yellow to rose fall leaf color.	12-18"	<i>Prunus serotina</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
NEW! Coffeetree, Kentucky Grows to 80' tall, 50' wide in full to part sun. Large compound leaf with many leaflets. Female trees bear brown pods that persist through winter. Seeds toxic raw, but were historically roasted as a coffee substitute.	12-18"	<i>Gymnocladus dioicus</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$8
Dogwood, White Flowering Grows 15-40' tall. Beautiful white flowers in the spring. Red leaves in the fall. Red berries eaten by numerous song and game birds and other wildlife. Prefers moist, rich soils.	12-18"	<i>Cornus florida</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6
Gum, Black Height 30-50' tall in many soil types. Full sun to part shade. Small greenish-white flowers and dark blue fruit. Scarlet fall foliage.	12-18"	<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6
Hickory, Shellbark Height 60-80' tall. Straight trunk, shiny dark green leaves, and a sweet, edible nut. Does well in medium soils to wet bottomlands and marginal floodplains.	12-18"	<i>Carya laciniosa</i>	1 for \$3, 5 for \$11
Maple, Sugar Height 75' tall. Popular shade and ornamental tree. Prefers full sun to part shade in moist soils. Its sap can be used for maple syrup. Brilliant scarlet-orange fall foliage.	12-18"	<i>Acer saccharum</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6

	<u>Size</u>	<u>Species</u>	<u>Price</u>
Oak, Red 	12-18"	<i>Quercus rubra</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
Height 70-80' in full to part sun, dry to medium soils. Dense green foliage turns deep red in fall. Relatively fast growing. Tolerant of urban conditions. Very valuable to wildlife, moths and butterflies.			
Paw Paw 	12-18"	<i>Asimina triloba</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$9
Grows 12-20'. Slow growing. Maroon flowers in spring. Prefers deep fertile soils and full sun. Highly nutritious custard-like fruit with a tropical flavor ripens in late summer to fall. Two needed for fruiting.			
Persimmon, American 	12-18"	<i>Diospyros virginiana</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
Height 30-60'. Orange fruit is sweet after frost. Full sun to part shade, moist to dry soils. More than one tree needed for good fruit set.			
NEW! Plum, American 	12-18"	<i>Prunus americana</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
Height and width of 15-25' in full sun to part shade. White flowers become small red plums good for preserves. It can have short thorns on branches and will send out suckers. Yellow to red fall color.			
Serviceberry, Allegheny 	12-18"	<i>Amelanchier laevis</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$7
Also known as Juneberry. Height 25', width 15'. White fragrant flowers become sweet purple fruit. Yellow to red fall color. Prefers moist, acidic, rich soils, but is adaptable. Full sun to partial shade.			
Tulip Poplar 	12-18"	<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6
Height 80-150'. Prefers moist well-drained soil in full sun, but will tolerate part shade. Has green tulip shaped leaves and flowers (greenish-yellow with an orange base). Blooms in mid-June.			

Shrubs (Native)







	<u>Size</u>	<u>Species</u>	<u>Price</u>
Elderberry 	12-18"	<i>Sambucus canadensis</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$5
Fast growing up to 10' tall and 8' wide. Needs full sun. Grows in any soil type and is wetland tolerant. White flowers bloom in the summer. Blue-black berries are used to make jelly, preserves and wine.			
Spicebush 	12-18"	<i>Lindera benzoin</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6
Grows 6-12'. Very showy deciduous shrub that is very tolerant of wet, shady conditions. Tiny clusters of small white flowers in spring and scarlet fruit in fall. Oblong, aromatic green leaves turn yellow in fall.			
NEW! Spirea, Meadowsweet 	12-18"	<i>Spiraea alba</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$8
Spikes of white flowers from June -August. Narrow, toothed green leaves. Height and width of 3-4' in full sun to part shade, moist to wet soil. Does well in rain gardens and along ponds.			
NEW! Willow, Pussy 	12-18"	<i>Salix discolor</i>	1 for \$2, 5 for \$6
Multi-stemmed with a height of 6-15' and width of 4-12' Full sun to part shade and medium to wet soil. Named for the large, fuzzy, silvery catkins, showier on male plants, that open very early spring.			

Groundcovers & Vines (Native)

	<u>Size</u>	<u>Species</u>	<u>Price</u>
NEW! Bittersweet, American 	18-24"	<i>Celastrus scandens</i>	5 for \$7
Deciduous twining vine that can grow up structures or allowed to ramble. Full sun to light shade and moist to dry soil. Female plants produce showy orange-red seed capsules at the end of short side branches.			
Juniper, Creeping 	6-12"	<i>Juniperus horizontalis</i>	5 for \$8
Low-growing. 1-2' tall and up to 10' wide. Blue-green scale-like foliage, purplish edges in winter. Sun to part-shade. Great for dry areas, for retaining walls, foundations and erosion control. Native to northern U.S.

Evergreens (Conifers)


	<u>Size</u>	<u>Species</u>	<u>Price</u>
Arborvitae  NATIVE. (Northern White Cedar) Height 40'. Evergreen foliage is scale-like and flat. For windbreaks, plant 4' apart. Red squirrels and birds like the seeds.	12-18"	<i>Thuja occidentalis</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$38
Cedar, Red  NATIVE. Grows 30-65'. Full sun, dry to moist soil. Dark green 'scale-like' foliage. Reddish brown bark exfoliates in thin strips on mature trees. Blue berry-like cones on female trees a favorite of many birds.	10-16"	<i>Juniperus virginiana</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$30
Pine, White  NATIVE. Grows 75-100'. Soft blue-green needles 3-5" long. Prefers moist sandy loam soil, full sun.	10-18"	<i>Pinus strobus</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$31
Spruce, Colorado Blue  Grows 80-100'. Needles 1-1.5" long. Color varies from green to silver blue. Likes ordinary soil, average moisture & full sun. Slowest growing, but most popular spruce. Ornamental, windbreaks, Christmas trees.	12-18"	<i>Picea pungens</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$34
Spruce, Norway  Grows 60-90'. Dark green needles. Branches droop gracefully as tree matures. Does well in average soil, but prefers moist soil to maintain a deep green color. Ornamental, or used as timber or for windbreaks.	10-18"	<i>Picea abies</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$11
Spruce, White  Native to northern U.S. Grows 40-60'. Green to gray-green needles, 1/3 to 3/4" long. Likes moist soil & full sun. Good as an ornamental or in windbreaks in both rural and urban areas. Common for Christmas trees.	12-18"	<i>Picea glauca</i>	1 for \$2, 25 for \$27

Wildflowers/Perennials (Native) all in 1 gallon pots, \$8.00 each




Blue False Indigo: *Baptisia australis* -    **Nf** Deep blue flowers with blue-green foliage. Deep rooted, slow growing, and long lived. Reaches 3-5'. Full sun, dry to moist soil. Deer-resistant.

Butterflyweed: *Asclepias tuberosa* -    Bright orange blossoms. Blooms June - August and reaches a height of 2-3'. Full to part sun and well drained, dry to moist soils. Great for monarch butterflies.

Cardinal Flower: *Lobelia cardinalis* -   Bright red flower spikes. Grows to a height of 2-5'. Blooms July-September. Loved by hummingbirds. Full sun to nearly full shade, wet to moist soil.

Great Blue Lobelia: *Lobelia siphilitica* -   Grows 2 -3' tall with showy spike of blue flowers from July - September. Does best in medium to wet soils in full sun to part shade. Great for a Rain Garden!

NEW! Oak Sedge: *Carex pensylvanica*. -   Arching grass-like leaves and brown seed capsules top the stems. Great for clumping displays with shade perennials or a flowing groundcover in dry to moist shaded areas.

Swamp Milkweed: *Asclepias incarnata* -    Mauve flowers attract butterflies, especially monarchs, who need milkweed to survive. Grows 2-4'. Great for a rain garden, and equally wonderful for dry areas.
